Provision of **223,222** food basket to **51000** HHs throughout **2021**

YFCA - Feb, 10 Thurs, 2022

Under YFCA's FSL program funded by World Food Program (WFP), YFCA provided in-kind food assistance to the most food insecure vulnerabilities within the project of General Food Assistance (GFA) targeting 51000 BNFs with 11 distribution cycles in 7 districts: Taiz Governorate (Saber Al-Mawadem, As-Shamayatin, Maqbanah, Mashra'a Wa Hadnan, Sala, Almakha). -Al-Mahweet Governorate (At-Tawilah).



COMPLETION OF WASIT WELL REHABILITATION

YFCA - Jan, 26 Wed, 2022

(YFCA) has repaired and rehabilitated the Wasit well in Markha Al-Sufla district of Shabwah Governorate by providing and Installing a solar system as well as covering roundly the area of the well and treating water quality by using a chlorine injection device to ensure access to clean and safe water. This intervention was funded by the German Foreign Ministry (AA) in partnership with Diakonie Katastrophenhilfe (DKH) (German Humanitarian Assistance Organization) and it served around 7000 beneficiaries.

Starting of Cash-for-Work Activity

YFCA - Sun, 06 FEB, 2022

(YFCA) started the cash-for-work activity on Monday morning, 01/24/2022 in Jabal al-Hubbush area, Khanfar district, Abyan governorate, affiliated to the livelihoods project, which consists of two main activities; cash-for-work and vocational training such as tailoring training

and hairdressing training during (3) consecutive months within Food Security and Livelihood sector(FSL) interventions. Funded by the Yemen Humanitarian Fund (YHF), in coordination with the local authorities in the governorate.

Rapidly response to the newly IDPs of Shabwah

YFCA - Wed , 23 Feb, 2022

Due to the armed conflict, and funded by the German Foreign Ministry (AA) in partnership with Diakonie Katastrophenhilfe (DKH) (German Humanitarian Assistance Organization), (YFCA) rapidly response to newly IDPs by distributing Rapid Response Mechanism (RRM) kits to 32 households in Aatq district in Shabwah Governorate, where the response process were conducted according to Rapid Response Mechanism (RRM) project protocol.



ACCOMPLISHMENT OF 150 FAMILY LATRINES CONSTRUCTION

YFCA - Wed , 23 Feb, 2022

YFCA completely constructed 150 family latrines for 150 households in two targeted districts (Markha Al-Sufla and Jordan) of Shabwah Governorate, as part of the Cash for WASH strategy, by providing the beneficiaries with tools, materials, and labor support, as well as plastic bowls of 50 liters, water jugs of 2.5 liters, and sanitation awareness posters were distributed.

Completion of Al-Karmoom Al-Madid well rehabilitation

Within the project of WASH and humanitarian food assistance for IDPs, host communities, returnees and marginalized groups in six districts of Shabwah Governorate-Yemen, which is funded by the German Foreign Ministry (AA) in partnership with Diakonie Katastrophenhilfe (DKH) (German Humanitarian Assistance Organization), YFCA has repaired and rehabilitated the Al-Hanak well in the Nisab district of Shabwah Governorate by supplying, installing, and operating the solar system with a motor and submersible water pump, including all accessories, as well as covering the well with protection walls, and also rehabilitating the two engine rooms and installing a chlorine injection device that works with the solar system to ensure that the beneficiaries have safe access to clean water, and the number of beneficiaries from this well is about 9000 beneficiaries.



A Work-shop conducted to set-up commodities management guideline

YFCA - Mar, 23 Wed, 2022

under objective 3 of building capacities of HWs at the targeted facilities and specifically for commodities and ware-housing, SHARP project partners cooperated with MoPH & reviewed the already existing guideline manual in commodities management, and as an output, the guideline was treated, edited and formulated to get an initial draft. Accordingly, it was circulated to preview feedback and get final approval. The final commodities management guideline is designed and released upon which YFCA led by JSI arranged for a workshop that took place on the 28th of February, where the three targeted districts health directors participated and attended the event. To ensure valuable outcomes of the workshop, JSI formally invited the meant focal points per each district, events the event is concluded and guideline is endorsed where the agreed comments and action were submitted in order to be added before health worker's capacities takes place.



Maintenance of Three Water Networks

Within the project of WASH and humanitarian food assistance for IDPs, host communities, returnees and marginalized groups in six districts of Shabwah Governorate-Yemen, which is funded by the German Foreign Ministry (AA) in partnership with Diakonie Katastrophenhilfe (DKH) (German Humanitarian Assistance Organization), YFCA has repaired and maintained three water networks, Ataq water network, Al Shabakaa water network in Ataq district and Nisab water network in Nisab district of Shabwah Governorate.



RRM kits distribution

Within the WASH and humanitarian food assistance for IDPs, host communities, returnees, and marginalized groups in six districts of Shabwah Governorate-Yemen, which is funded by the German Foreign Ministry (AA) in partnership with Diakonie Katastrophenhilfe (DKH) (German Humanitarian Assistance Organization), 27 RRM kits for the eighth response were distributed within 72 hours to 16 households in coordination with the Executive Unit of IDPs in Shabwah Governorate.
