


ENGAGEMENT..




Solar-energy go-live!

July 2019/ Sa'adah: UNICEF and YFCA carry out a water project targeting 89,000+ people in Sa'adah. Two water borholes in Majz district are being refurbished by linking them to an integrated solar-power pmping system to leverage access to clean drinking water with a lasting system that require minimal operation cost. The project incorporates also the revamp of water-associated resources of the health facilities in the districts of Haydan, Ghamr and Monabeh.
