Dec 19, 2020/ Juban district, Al Dhale governorate, Yemen:

Funded by the UNOCHA's Yemen Humanitarian Fund (YHF), YFCA's CEO has inaugurated the solar-powered pumping unit for Libah valley's groundwater-well in Juban district of Al Dhale governorate; the well serves sustainably the whole 120,000+ population of Juban district. Following this launching, the YFCA team has met with the local authorities and the Local Water and Sanitation Corporation (LWSC) in the district to deliberate about water-related challenges and ways to synergize.

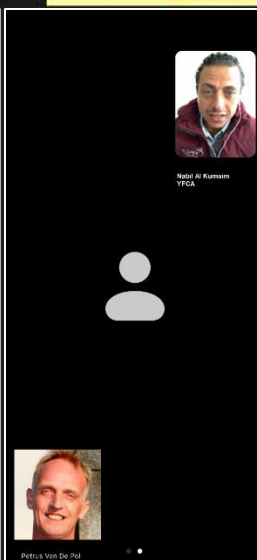


ACAPS' HAP!

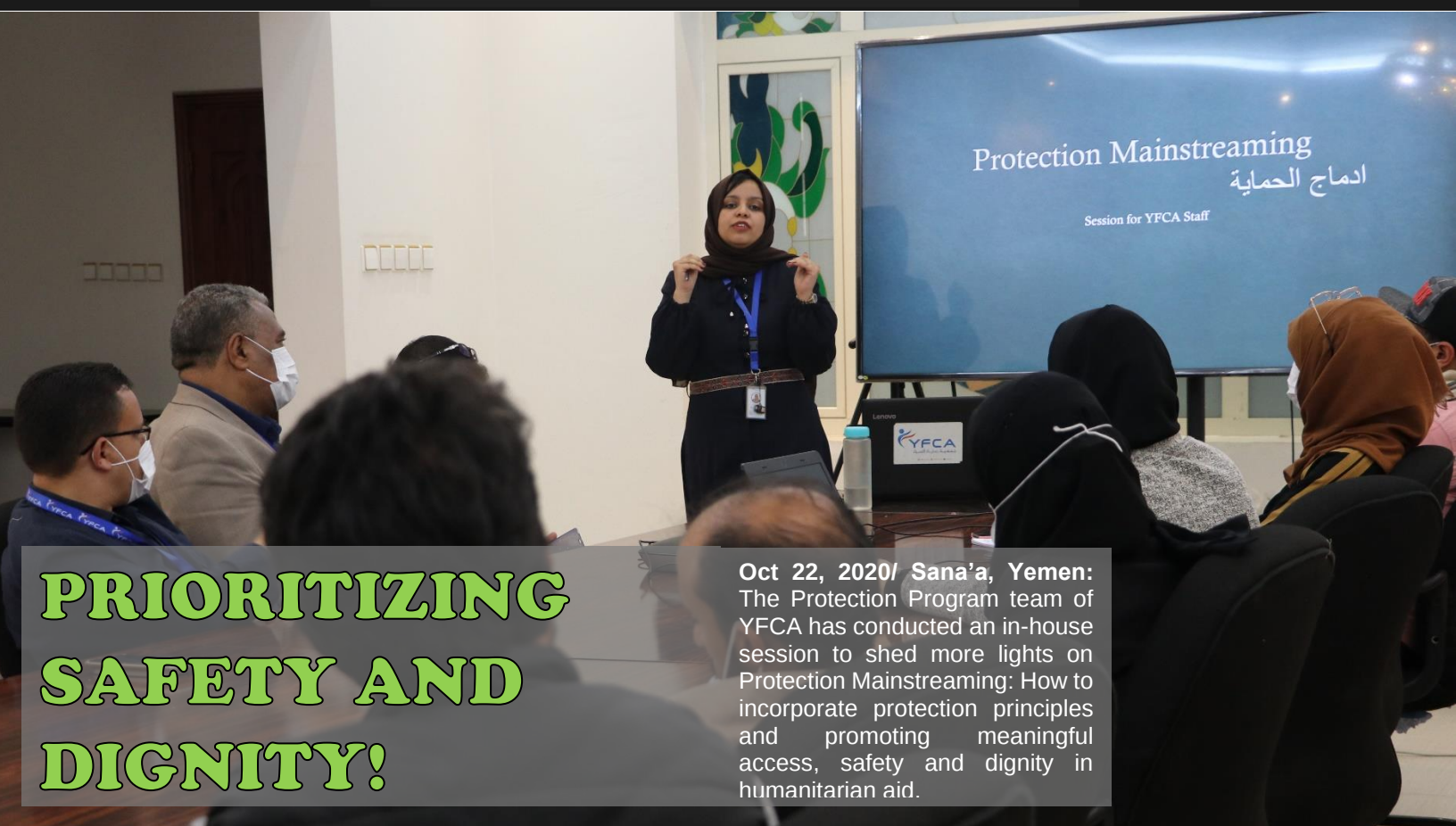
